



Year 6 Curriculum Plan- Spring

English

We will begin the year by reading Skellig by David Almond and making predictions about who the man in the garage is. Other texts that will inspire a range of writing this term are: The Day the Crayons Quit by Drew Daywalt, The Highwayman by Alfred Noyes and Macbeth by William Shakespeare. Towards the end of the term, we will focus on grammar in preparation for SATs.

Maths

This term our topics are: algebra, geometry, statistics and ratio and proportion. There will also be a daily focus on arithmetic and problem solving.

Science

Our topic of the term is Animals, including Humans. We will focus in detail on the circulatory and digestive systems and find out how we can keep ourselves healthy.

Geography

We will be learning about trade patterns around the world, including fair trade.

History

We will be learning about what caused the Viking raids in Britain.

Key vocabulary

Geography- settlement, land use, energy food minerals, globalisation, export, import, fairtrade, LEDC, MEDC.

History- Scandinavia, longship, shield, helmet, invade, fierce, warrior, raid, longhouse, odin, thor

Science-pulmonary, vein, artery, aorta, aortic valve, ventricle, oxygenated blood, deoxygenated blood.

In art, we will draw portraits and make mosaics.

In DT we will be learning how to do blanket stitch to create felt phone cases or pencil cases.
